PROPOSING A \$9,000,000 BOND FOR SCHOOL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION

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Changes since January 2023 Referendum Vote

Enrollment continues to increase - Currently at 344 Students (K-12)

- Increase of 21 students compared to last year (6% increase)
- Increase of 85 students over last 5 years (33% increase)
- Increase of 170 students since 2014 referendum (200% increase)

Construction costs continue to increase annually at 3%-5%

• The overall project budget has not changed. Our needs remain the same.

The proposed Tax Impact is significantly less than it was in January 2023.

- Why? The County Commissioners generously awarded the school district \$10 million dollars.
- A portion of the money received was used to pay down existing debt which reduced the overall tax levy in 2023. Our debt was reduced from \$11.75 Million to \$4.31 Million.
- A portion of the money received was put into the building fund. The school district has saved \$10 million to be used towards new construction (compared to just \$5 million saved at the time of the previous referendum).
- These changes have reduced the proposed Mill increase on the referendum from 32.19 Mills (proposed in January 2023) to 18.49 Mills.
- Between the debt paydown and the reduced Mills on the proposed referendum - the NET difference in Mills from Tax Year 2022 to Tax Year 2024 will be an increase of approximately 5.56 Mills. This increase amounts to about \$25/year for a \$100,000 home or about 9-cents per acre for average ag land.

What's in the Proposed Plan?

- 10 new classrooms will be added to accommodate two sections of every grade and includes a 2nd floor where the middle school students will be located.
- 2 Additional kitchen / cafeteria space.
- A new identifiable and secure building entrance with improved safety and security.
 - The reception area will have adequate space for working with students, staff, and visitors.
 - A conference room accessible through the main office will accommodate board meetings, parent meetings, and staff meetings.
 - A staff workroom that is flexible and centralized will provide an efficient area for teachers to work, collaborate, and train.
 - Additional offices allow our administrative staff, counselors, and nurse to be in one area.
- Several classrooms did not receive updates to the HVAC or lighting during the 2016 project. This project will address capital maintenance improvements to classrooms that includes: fire sprinklers, new heating / cooling, and lighting upgrades. This will reduce annual maintenance and operating costs.



OUESTION #1

Shall Alexander Public School District No. 2 of McKenzie County, North Dakota, issue its general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$9,000,000 maturing within a maximum of 20 years, resulting in an estimated additional millage of 18.49 mills, equal to \$18.49 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation for the first taxable year, for the purpose of providing funds, together with any other funds available, to construct an addition to and a remodel of the existing facility, to include new classrooms, administrative offices, kitchen and cafeteria space, and mechanical and electrical upgrades, and to otherwise improve and renovate school property and make site improvements.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

Voters desiring to vote in favor of the foregoing propositions should mark a cross (X) in the space opposite the word "Yes." Voters desiring to vote against such propositions should mark a cross (X) in the space opposite the word "No."

WHAT THE BALLOT SAYS AND WHAT IT MEANS

- 20-year loan, maximum.
 Fixed payment, can be paid off early without penalty.
- Increase of 18.49 mills required to make loan payment
- Equal to \$18.49 on each \$1,000 of <u>taxable valuation</u>. See the example below for additional explanation.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST ME?

 Every property owner's situation is different. To identify your tax imapot, refer to your most recent Real Estate Tax Statement.

Important note: <u>Taxable valuation</u> is different than True and Full Value and also different than the market value of your property.

• A financial overview with average property values is provided below.

Here is an example of how to calculate your tax impact:

Taxable Value x Mills Increase / 1000

- Taxable Value is found on your tax statement.
- Mills Increase is 18.49 as noted on the ballot.

\$4,500 x 18.49/ 1000 = \$83.22 per year or \$6.94 per month
