A Public Hearing on the application in Case No. PU-23-361 is scheduled for February 16, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. Mountain Time at the High Plains Community Center, 100 Fifth Avenue Southwest, Killdeer, ND 58640.

On December 15, 2023, Basin Electric Power Cooperative filed a combined application for a corridor certificate and a route permit to construct approximately 32.5 miles of 345 kV electric transmission line and associated facilities extending from the existing Kummer Ridge Substation in McKenzie County, North Dakota to the existing Roundup Substation in Dunn County, North Dakota, also as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

- 1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
- 2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
- 3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
