The Laborers District Council of Minnesota and North Dakota ("LIUNA") does not object to a decision by the North Dakota Public Service Commission ("Commission") to grant the August 18, 2023 Petition for Reconsideration filed by Applicant SCS Carbon Transport LLC ("Summit") in the matter of Summit's proposed Midwest Carbon Express Project, provided that LIUNA is able to participate in any consideration process approved by the Commission in this matter as a full party in order to protect the interests of members and construction workers generally..

While we understand the concerns expressed by intervenors and have shared some of our own, we appreciate Summit's continuing efforts to mitigate potential project impacts and to share additional information with the public, including with respect to the company's contracting plans. It is our hope the proposed rehearing would provide an opportunity for Summit to sufficiently address these concerns without starting the process over, which would cause significant delays and impose burdens on participants, including our organization. We trust that the Commission can arrive at a decision that balances the need for public review of proposed changes to the project with the opportunity to use the existing robust record rather than starting from scratch.
