NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING

June 9, 2021

A Public Hearing on the applications in Case No. PU-21-150 is scheduled to begin **July 12, 2021, at 8:30 A.M. CT, at the Energy Wellness Center, 1900 Central Avenue North, Beulah, ND 58523.**

On April 23, 2021, Dakota Gasification Company filed a combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit concerning the location of approximately 2.9 miles of 12-inch and 3.9 miles of 6-inch outside diameter carbon dioxide gas pipeline in Mercer County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facilities at the proposed locations produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will construction, operation, and maintenance of the facilities at the proposed locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

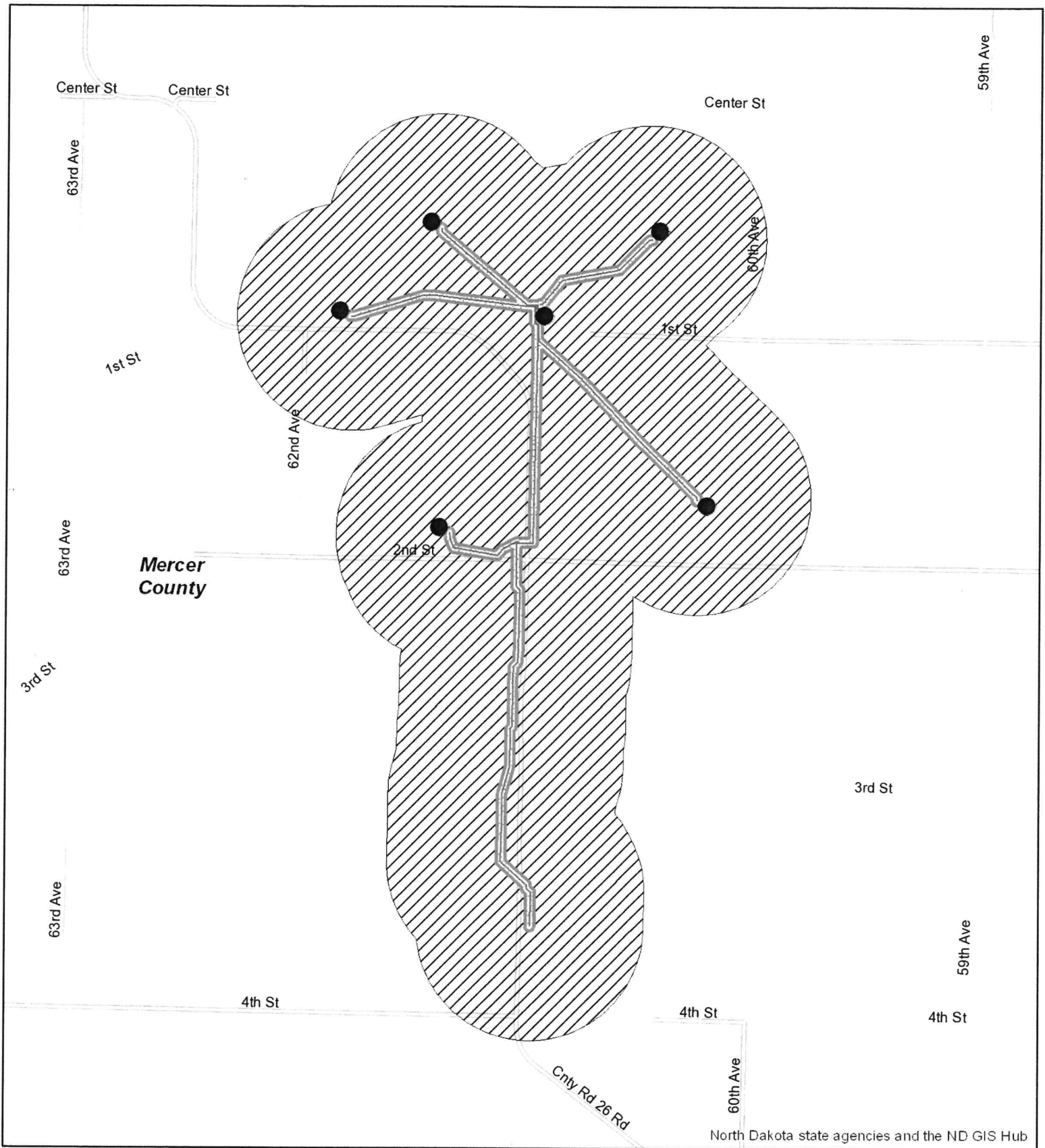

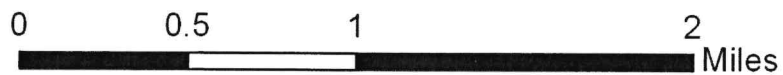
