While everyone appreciates the need for transparency and accountability in government spending, we also recognize the importance of efficiency and avoidance of unnecessary bureaucratic mandates.

Zach Gaaskjolen City of Stanley HB 1179 proposes the repeal of a section of law intended to ensure accountability of counties which are allocated revenue through the gross production tax distribution formula, but the practical application of this section of Century Code has demonstrated that it is an unnecessary reporting burden imposed on auditors in counties that receive GPT revenue.
