

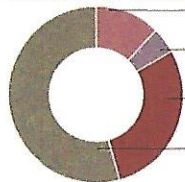

What Will this Cost Me?

Distribution of Tax Burden



Residential 12.1%
 Agricultural 4.6%
 Commercial 29.4%
 Oil & Gas Industry/Utilities 53.9%

The combination of commercial, oil and gas industry, and utilities make up 83% of this building project in terms of the mill obligation. This is a tremendous advantage for the residential and agricultural property owner

of MCPSD #1 and ensures the fixed income taxpayer is not burdened with a majority of the taxes for this project.

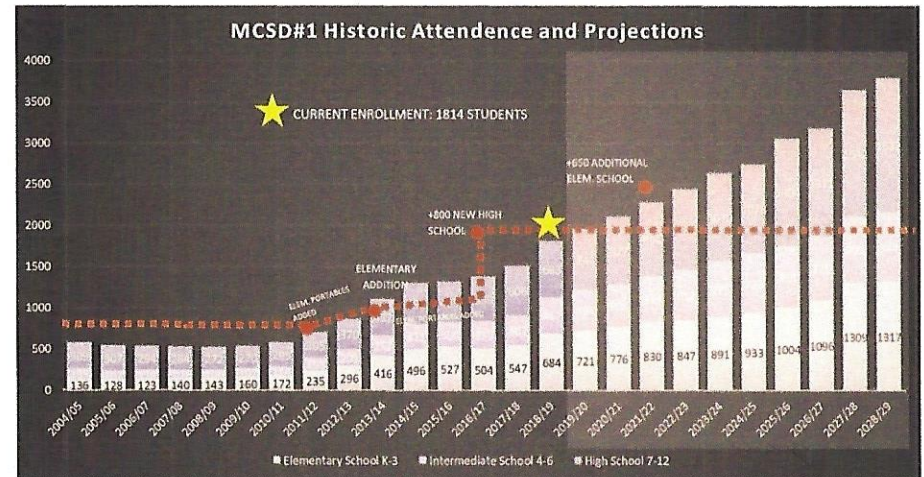

#1 What happens if the Bond issue to Build an Additional Elementary School Fails?

If bond issue #1 does not pass, the district will have to place the excess student population in portable units or alternate locations. This will affect classroom learning objectives, make lunchtime and recess schedules unmanageable, and cause the pick up and drop off times to be chaotic. Not to mention, recruitment of teachers to portable units and overcrowded classrooms will be very difficult.



WE WILL OUTGROW OUR CURRENT SCHOOL BUILDINGS

Current Enrollment is 1,814. By 2025 we will be over **3,000** students.

#2 Why is it necessary to approve future funding?

Question #2 allows for flexibility in addressing the future facility and infrastructure needs of the school district related to student growth – the school district does not plan to utilize this increased capacity (if passed) until it is needed for any future projects. In short, if Question #2 is passed; it will not have an immediate impact on the taxpayer's burden and will only potentially offset any future projects savings as the valuations increase and other needs arise based on the pace of student enrollment growth.



VOTING REQUIREMENTS

You must present:

- Either a valid North Dakota driver's license or a non-driver's identification card.
- A student identification certificate provided by a North Dakota college or university.
- Long-term care identification certificate provided by a North Dakota facility.
